UPDATE ON RADIO SYSTEMS

City Manager Greg Smith reviewed the purchases with council. Council instructed Mr. Smith to purchase the appliances and dispatch consoles since they are under \$50,000. Mr. Smith said he will bring the air filler for the fire dept. in front of council Tuesday night.

City Manager Greg Smith stated the test was better than the system currently in place but not up to what was expected. Mr. Smith stated the 800 system is not feasible due to the cost. Mr. Smith stated he would like to go with the system presented to council previously. Council instructed Mr. Smith to bring his recommendations to them on Tuesday night for a vote.

DISCUSSION OF CLOSING DEVERAUX STREET AT THE NEW PUBLIC SAFETY COMPLEX PROPERTY LINE

City Manager Greg Smith told council due to the width of Deveraux street he felt it was necessary to close Deveraux at the city property line to through traffic. Mr. Smith stated he would bring this item back to council at a later time.

City Manager Greg Smith stated he would like to put a resolution on the agenda outlining what the council supports and does not support the legislature regulating in city operations. Council told Mr. Smith to present the resolution to them Tuesday night.
