- A. Contingent upon installation of asphalt parking lot sufficient to meet current building codes
- B. This Special Use permit will only be valid for 9 months from the date of approval.

Mayor Pro tem Rob Gowin made a motion to approve the special use permit with the specific conditions the permit be contingent upon the installation of parking lot that meets building codes and the permit expire March 10, 2022. Second by Councilman Tim McRae. All voted "Aye".
